



Situate in Codorus Township, York County containing as above  
 set forth 22 acres and 20 1/2 perches, and allowance. Originally surveyed on  
 the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1789 by Moses McClean late D.S. in pursuance of a war-  
 rant bearing date the 15<sup>th</sup> day of January 1789, granted to Philip Emich for  
 25 acres. Resurveyed, and a piece of vacant ground added to fill up the  
 warrant, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1810 for the present owner Michael Emich  
 And now, at his request returned for confirmation the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May
