

By virtue of a warrant dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December 1811 Surveyed unto William Erwin on the 26<sup>th</sup> December following the above described Island situate in the River Delaware called Laugheries Island partly opposite the mouth of Gall's run on the Pennsylvania Shore in Nockamixon Township Bucks County containing fourteen acres and sixteen perches & the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Dec. 28<sup>th</sup> 1811.
