Surveyed on the third day of december 1811, unto the aforesaid alexander Ewin Sen. the above discribed tract of land containing one hundred and ten acres and allowance proportioned at six Pr cent, situate in Donegall Township in the County of Westmoreland adjoining lands of Robert Micky on the whiteoak run, and others including his improvent commenced in the year of 1793
