In pursuance of a warrant for 74^{as} granted to Joseph Edmunson Junr bearing date the 2nd day of July A.D. 1790 Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land on the 2nd day of November A.D. 1805 and now at the request of the present owner Adam Spangler the same has been calculated examined &c and found to be correct, and at his request returned for confirmation this 6th day of May A.D. 1812
