



The above is a draught of a Lot of ground containing nine acres and twenty four perches and six tenths with the usual allowance of six per cent, situate on the waters of Cross creek in Washington County Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated 31st December 1814 which was granted to Joseph Ekin for twelve acres.

Executed March 18th 1815

P.S. The only improvement on this land is a small part of a field (which has been cleared for many years) represented by the small triangle in the S.W. corner of the draught.
