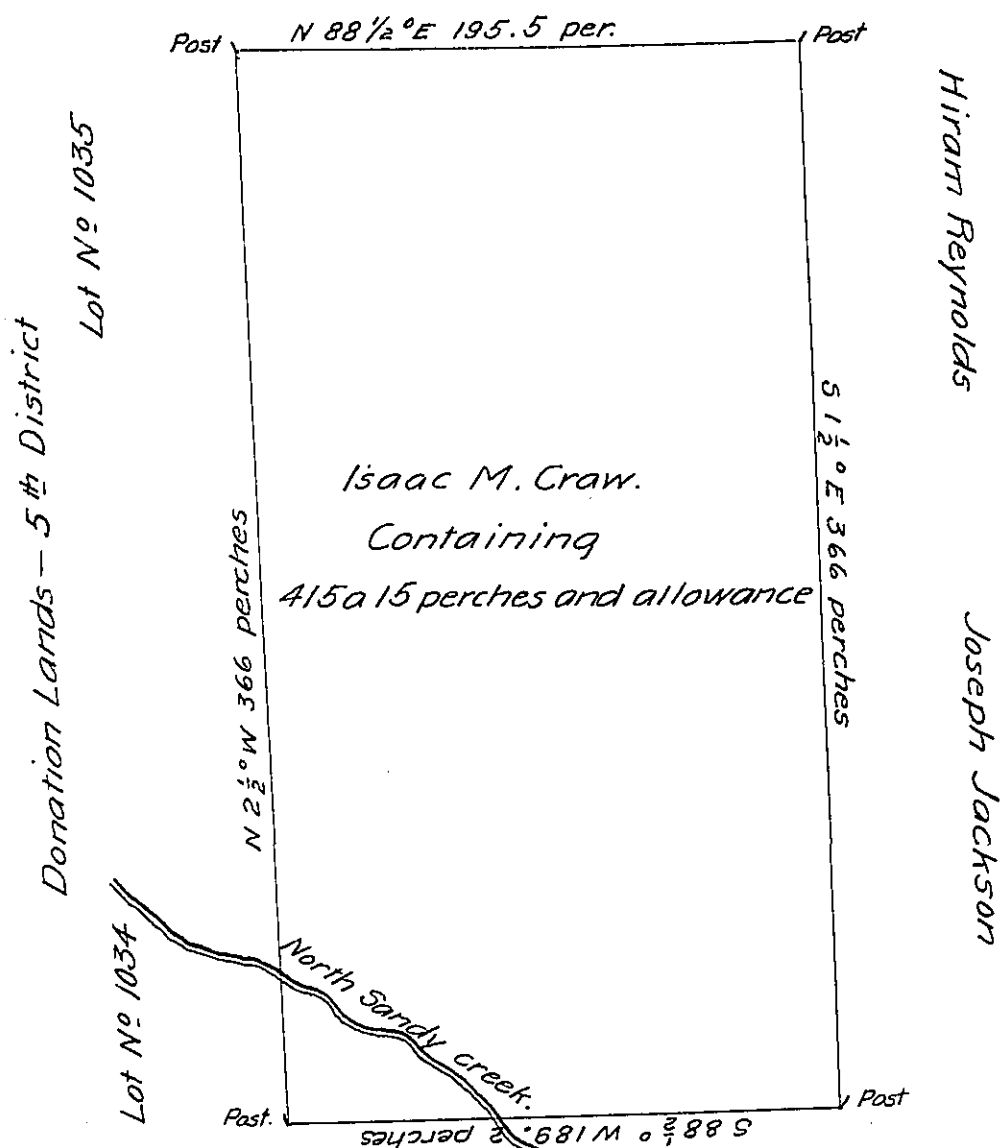


Robert Lindsay's Heirs

And I hereby certify that from the Survey Books in my possession the above described tract does not appear to have been surveyed to any other person than the said Isaac M. Crow or any other person under whom he claims the same by warrant or otherwise. In witness whereof I have hereto set my hand this 24th day of October A.D. 1851.
