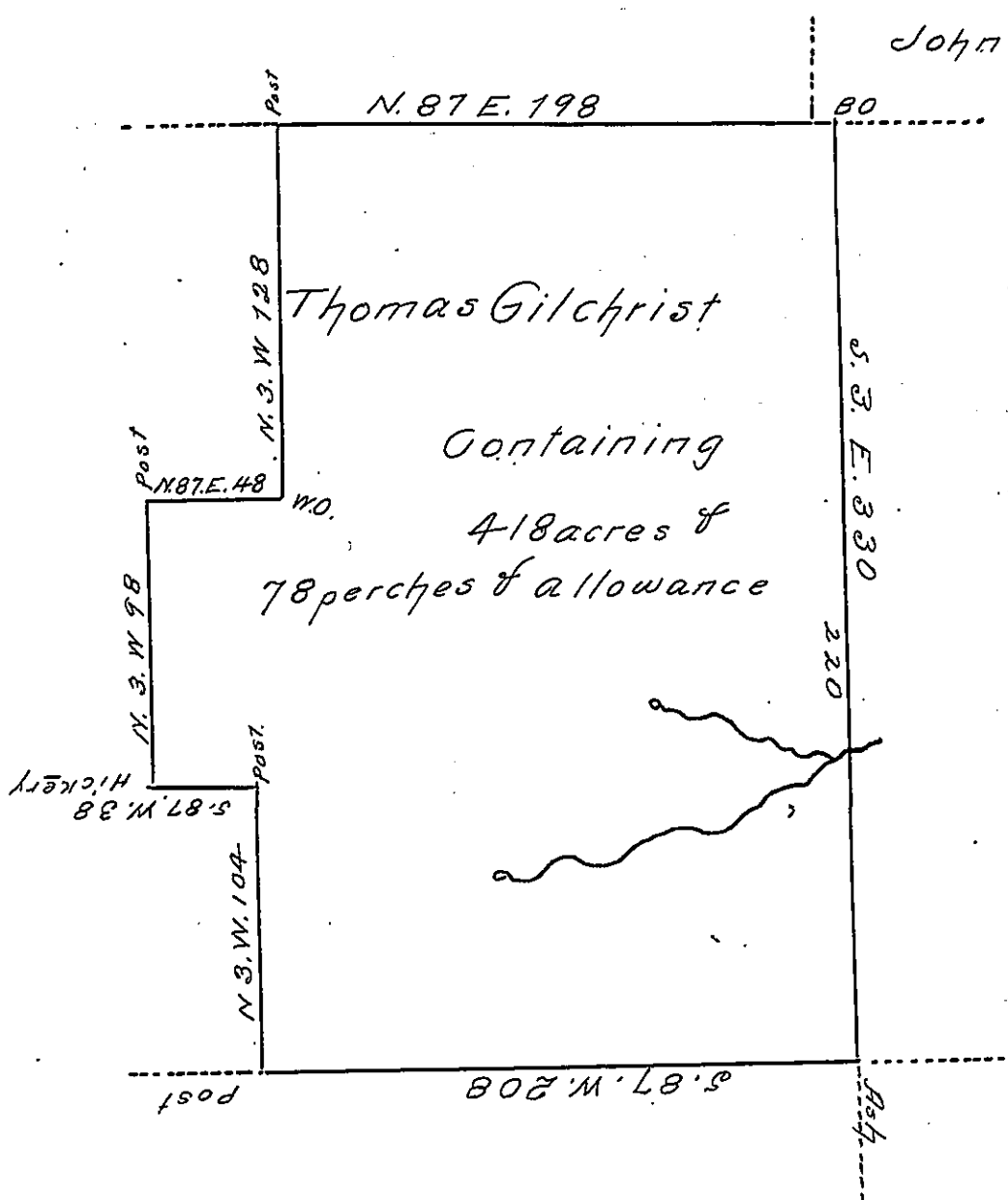

Situate - Centre Township Butler County and from the Books and Records in my possession it does not appear to be Surveyed or appropriated for the Redemption of Depreciation Certificates or otherwise and that I know of no person Claiming or Disputing with him about the same.
