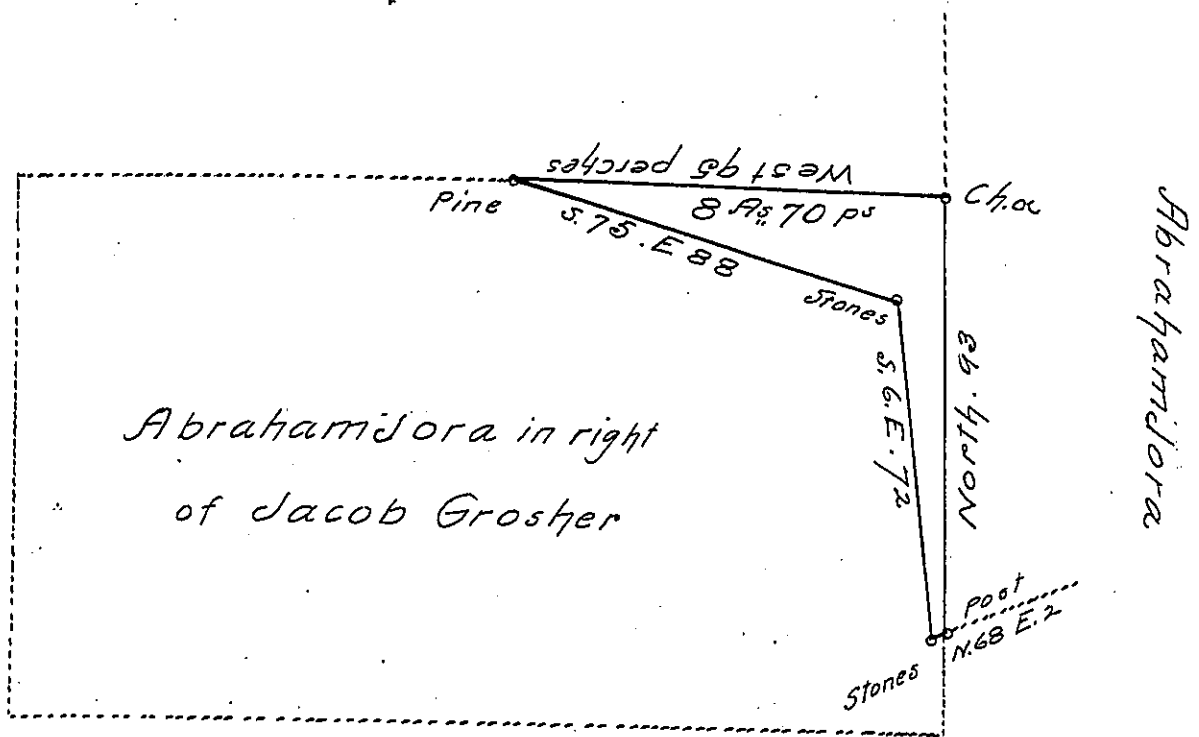


Abraham Jora



Surveyed February 25<sup>th</sup> 1809 by Levi G. Hollingsworth late deputy surveyor for Henry Meck the above described tract of land situate in Upper Paxton Township Dauphin County as appears by the rough Draft thereof remaining in my office containing Eight acres Seventy perches Allowance of six per cent part of One hundred forty seven Acres an half Allowance on Warrant of Jacob Grosher dated the 13<sup>th</sup> February 1775 which survey I have examined and find to be correct June 22 1813
