And now on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of December A.D. 1812. The above has been resurveyed by virtue of a Warrant of Resurvey granted to Jacob Folcomer bearing date the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 1812. and at his request returned for Confirmation
