Being part of a larger tract of 293 1/2 acres & allowance Originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 8th day of May 1753 in pursuance of a warrant for—^{as} granted to Millian Fissel, dated the 29th day of March 1753, The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract, on the 16th day of November 1791, and now at the request of Gabriel Bear the present owner of said part, the Draught is examined, found correct and returned for confirmation February 4th 1822
