



Situate in Franklin Township York County, containing within the black lines two acres, two perches, and allowance of six per cent for roads &c Being part of a larger tract of $174 \frac{1}{4}$ acres & allowance, Originally surveyed by Charles Lukens Esq late D.S. on the 21st day of December 1771 in pursuance of the application of Jacob Beals N^o 4684, dated the 8th of January 1768 - The above part resurveyed and divided off the said larger tract for John Fickis, at whose request the same is returned for confirmation August 30th 1821.
