



In Pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres dated the 13th day of April A.D. 1792 granted to John Francis was surveyed on the 22^d day of November A.D. 1817 The above described tract of land containing 397 acres 107 perches and allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c. situated in Rockdail township, Crawford county, and at the time of making the same, John and Michal Bougher was residing thereon, and there was built a house fit for the habitation of man, and there appeared to be upwards of 50 acres of the land cleared, fenced and in a state of cultivation, ~~and that the same was divided as above stated, between,~~
