



Situate on the Hurricane Branch of Dunning's Creek in St. Clair (Now Napier) township Bedford county containing four hundred and sixteen acres seventy six perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Surveyed for John Ellis the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1844 on Warrant dated the 29<sup>th</sup> March 1802 granted to Thomas Ellis for 400 acres
