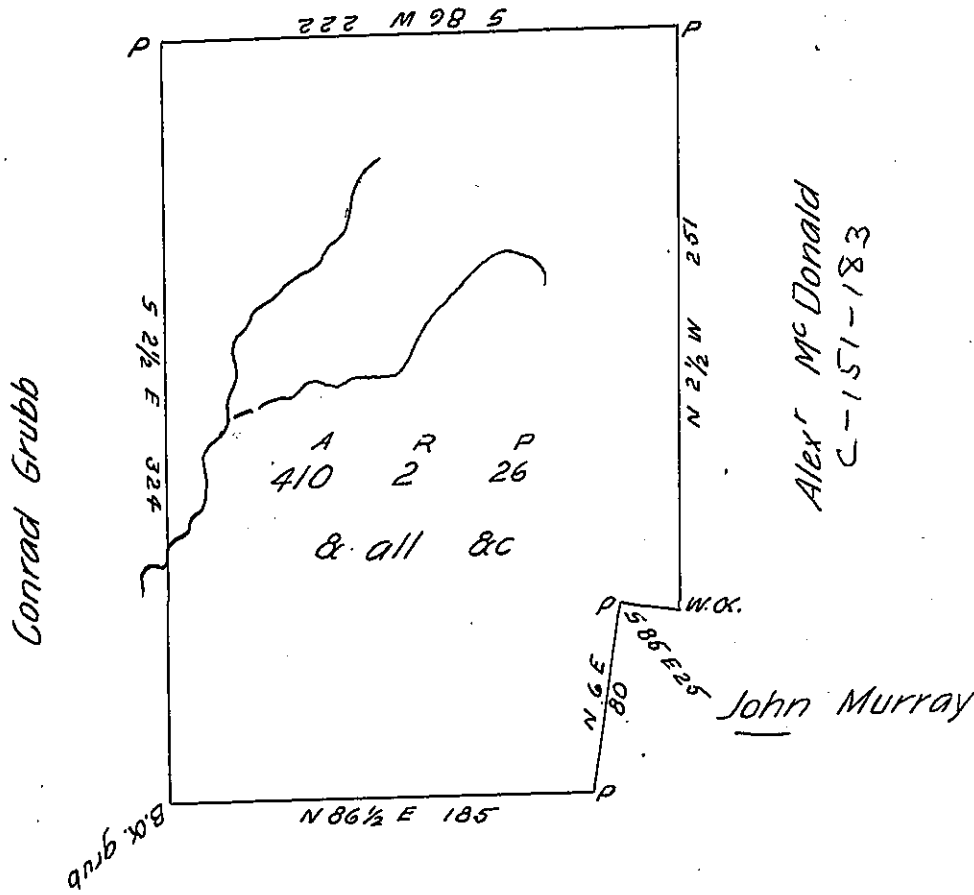


Depreciation Land

 his heirs by Virtue of a Warrant granted them dated the 18<sup>th</sup> January  
 1805.
