



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate on the Waters of Loyalsock Creek Adjoining Land of John Flowers & Others in Loyalsock Township in the County of Northumberland Survey'd on the first day of November 1788 for Richard Flowers in Pursuance of his Warrant bearing date the first day of July 1784 Containing Four Hundred & Nine acres & One Quarter with the allowance of Six p Cent for Roads &c.

This Warrant was Remov'd from the Waters of Catawassa Creek the Land being Appropriated as Appears by a Certificate under the Hand of the Deputy Surveyor of that District &c.
