



The above is a Draught of a Survey made April 26<sup>th</sup> Day 1788 Situate on the Waters of Wheeling in Washington County in Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Abraham Enlow 26<sup>th</sup> March 1788 - Called the Sugar Stick Run Containing three Hundred and Ninety one  $\frac{3}{4}$  Acres with Allowance of 6 Percent for Roads and highways.
