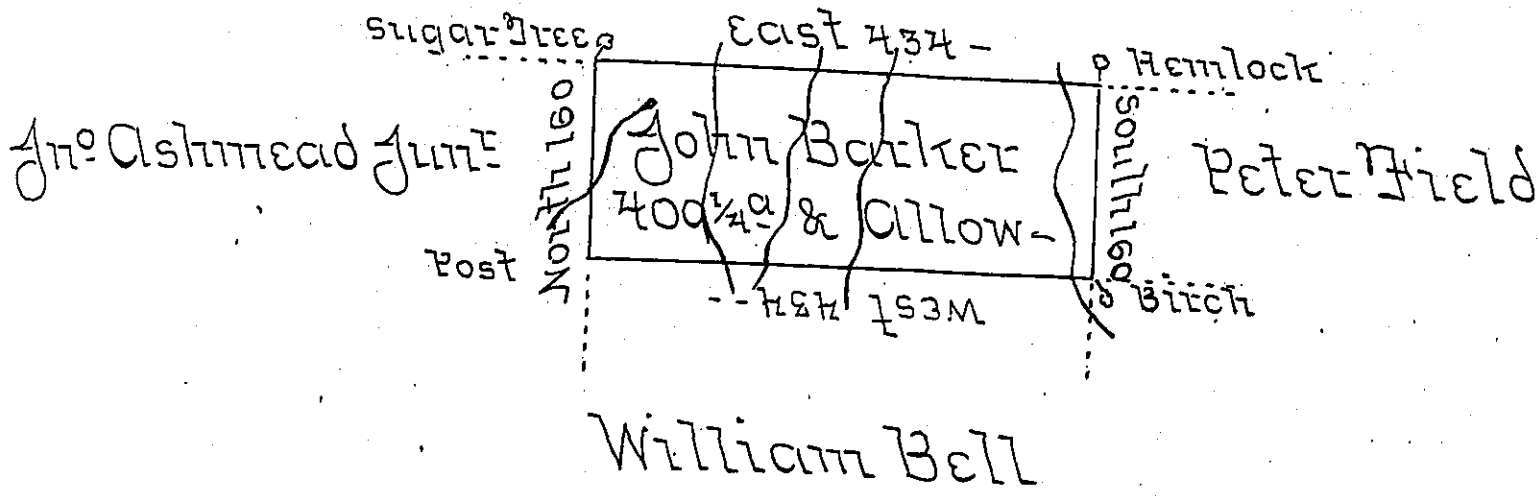


Vacant

A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the Waters of Loyalsock Creek Adjoining Land of William Bell & others in Loyalsock Township in the County of Northumberland, Surveyd on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 1788 for John Barker in Pursuance of his Warrant bearing date on the first day of July 1784. Containing Four Hundred & nine acres & one Quarter & the Allowance of six Percent for Roads &c. This Warrant was removed from the waters of Catawassa Creek the Land being Appropriated, as appears by a Certificate under the Hand of the Deputy Surveyor of that District &c.
