



Situate in Tyrone Township Huntingdon County containing one hundred and ten acres one hundred & fifty six Perches & the usual Allowance surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May 1791 in pursuance of a warrant for 150 acres dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785 -

Note a survey was made on the above Warrant on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785 and a return made by George Woods Esqr then Deputy Surveyor for this District now Huntingdon County part of which lay in the manor & part in Oliver Wallace's survey made and returned on an Order No 535 dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1776 -
