



Situate in Buffalo Township in the County of Northumberland Surveyed on the 15 day of August 1806 for Andrew Glenn, by virtue of his Warrant bearing date on the 16 day of December 1772. Containing one hundred and sixty six Acres and Ninety one perches and the usual Allowance of Six P Cent for Roads &c. It being a part of a Survey (obl.) for Andrew Glenn said to contain three hundred (obl.) Acres and 1/4. There appears to be a patent issued to Jacob Hook for one hundred & forty Acres of the same Tract.
