 the division line between ye lands Return'd for W^m Ewing
 & Alex^r McCausland, Part of each of those Surveys
 being included in the above one, so that upon ye
 Acceptance of this Survey into the Office both of
 the others must be rejected - The Office will
 Judge of the Proofs offered by Mr Hambright to
 ascertain the Identity of ye land - - -
 W^e issued to Accept the above ye 10th Jan 1774
