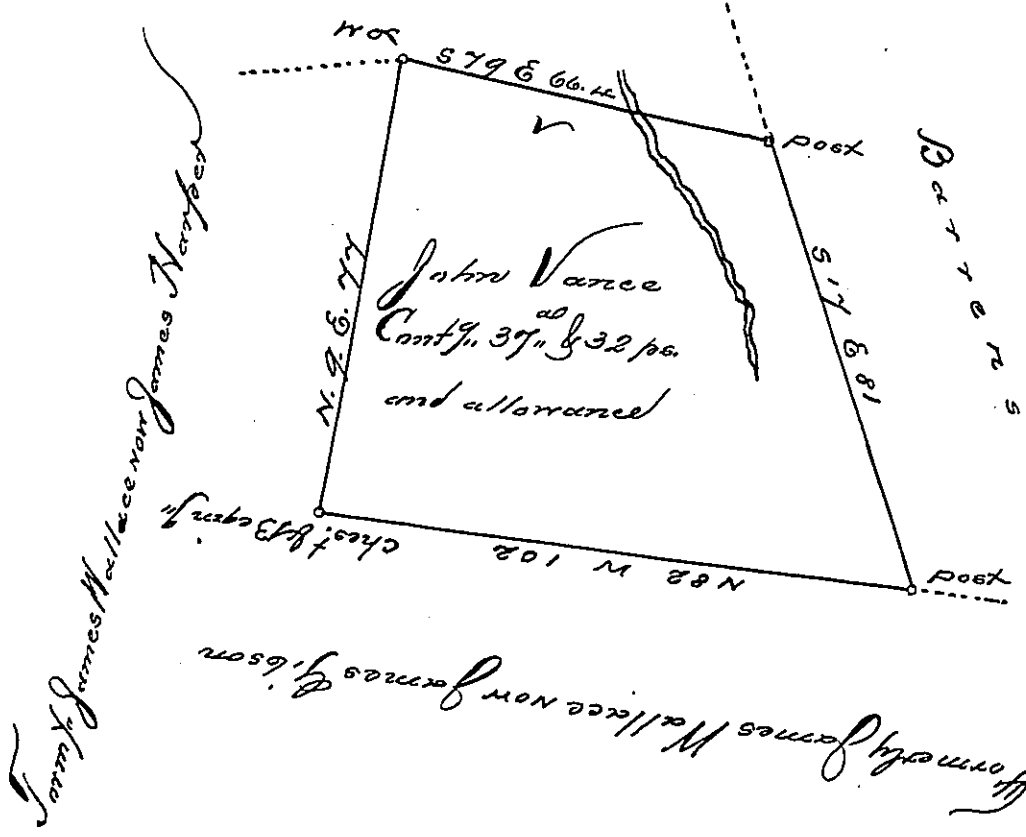


The other part of the whole Tract



Situate now in Hopewell Township, in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 37 1/2 & 32 perches and allowance. Being part of a larger Tract of land originally surveyed by William Mathews dated D.S. on the 1st day of the 12th month 1774 for John Heron. In pursuance of the Application No. 512/2 for 200^a granted to John Vance bearing date the 6th day of September A.D. 1768. Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger Tract of Land by Wm Kersey dated D.S. on the 6th of the 9th month 1783. And now at the request of the present owner James Gibson, I am desired to make return of the draught as calculated for a tract and examined the 30th day of June Anno Domini, 1809 - per
