



Situated in Moore's Pleasant Township York County - And Resurveyed for Thomas McCleary according to the old lines, by special Order from the Surveyor General on <sup>the</sup> third day of April 1782. In pursuance of a warrant granted to Henry Griffen of Lancaster County for 100. dated 21<sup>st</sup> May 1746. By Moses McCleary deceased.  
N.B. The part marked Peter Shriver (part of the original Survey) was granted by Patent to Peter Shriver on a Survey for David Davis, which Thomas McCleary has purchased from Peter Shriver, to prevent a suit at law, & which is included in the survey. The draught of which is in the Office as it was in the original Survey. A small error was also in the first survey adjoining Dan'l Hagle, as the lines could not then be found which is rectified in this -
