



This Draught describes a Tract of Land. Survey'd for John Gray the 26<sup>th</sup> day of 9<sup>ber</sup> 1748. In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him & Dated the 25<sup>th</sup> of May in the same year. Situate on a Branch of Octoraro & near a Place called Scotland in Drummore Towp. Lancaster County. Begins at a marked Chesnut in a Line of Robt Steen's Land & running thence N 65° E 79 P 5 to a Black Oak & c<sup>a</sup> as above. Scale of 80° to an Inch.
