In Turkeyfoot Township Somerset County &c Surveyed for William Hardy the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January 1816. In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December 1815 (the Wt for 61<sup>a</sup>)
