



From Papers in Deputy's Surveyor's Office of Lycoming County it appears that the above Discribed tract of Land was Survey'd on the 20th day of November 1792 By J. J. Wallace the then D.S. to John Weigle by Virtue of a Warrant granted to Joseph Hill the 29th Oct^r 1792. And at the Request of the present owner Joseph Hill Survey'd this 25th day January 1816. Containing one hundred & Ninety four Acres & twenty Six perches and allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Situate in Maneland (formerly Muncy) Township Lycoming County & bounded as above Discribed
