



A Draught of a tract of land Surveyed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January 1802. by Virtue of a Warrant Granted to John Hill for 100 Acres of land dated the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 1786. Situate on the Waters of Charters & ten Mile Creeks in Washington County. Called Mulberry Ridge containing one hundred twenty three Acres one hundred and twenty four perches together with Six p<sup>ct</sup> Cent allowance for Roads and High Ways.
