



A draft of a tract of land situated in the Twp of New Castle formerly a part of Norwegian Twp. Schuylkill County containing one hundred and twenty eight acres and six perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. surveyed for the Philadelphia and Reading Coal and Iron Company and for the heirs of Jacob W. Seitzinger deceased, the present owners of the undivided three fourths and one fourth part respectively on the tenth twelfth and twenty third days of June 1897, it being a part of a larger tract of two hundred acres and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted Phineas Freeman dated the 18 day of September 1824.
