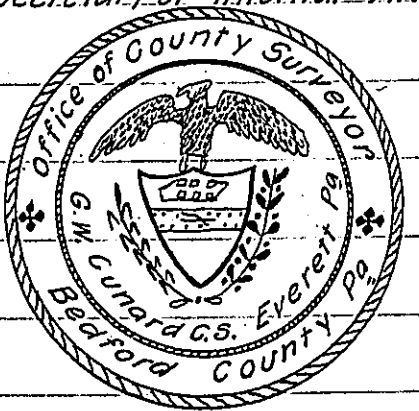


A draft of a tract of land situated in the Township of Napier and
