



Survey'd to George Gray on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1784, the above described Tract of three hundred & ninety eight acres & an half acre and allowance of Six p. Cent. Situate on a branch of Black Legs creek about four miles from the mouth of said creek, adjoining land surveyed to Andrew Simpson, James McConnell, Isaac Allen, Thomas Lowry & others in Westmorland County. By Warrant of the 23<sup>d</sup> day of August 1784.
