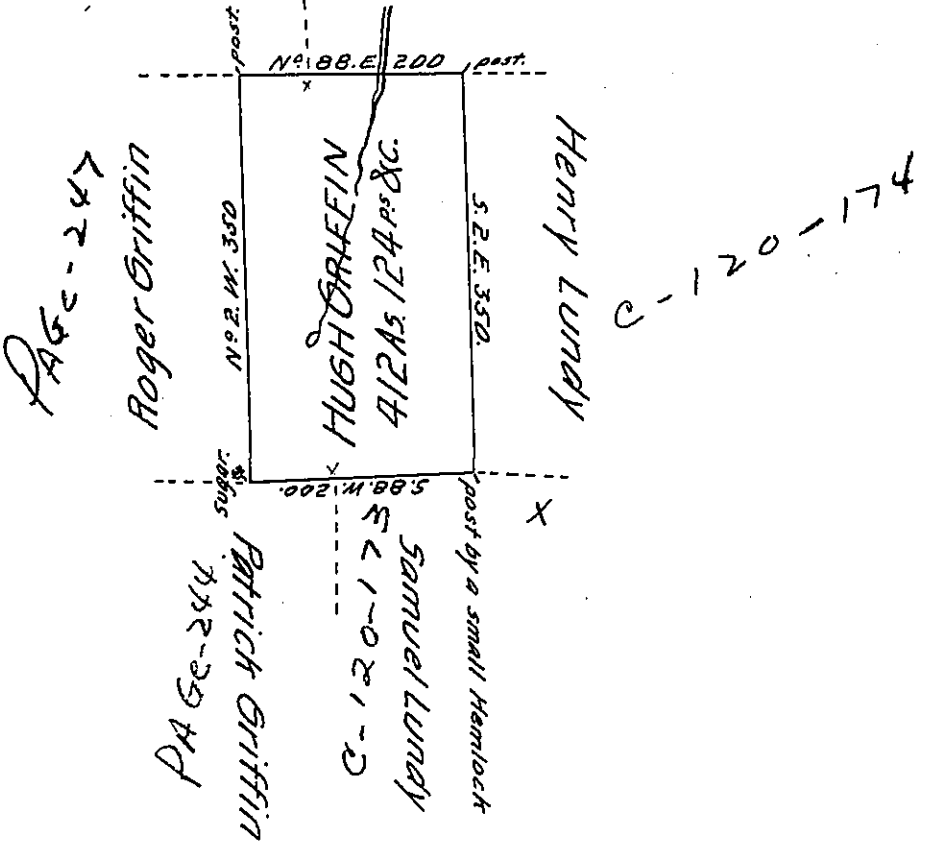


Paul Lundy James Lundy
