



The above is a Draught of a tract of land Call'd Casualty, Situate on the waters of Chartiers Creek in Somerset township Washington County, Containing Four acres and One hundred and seventeen perches and allowance of Six Per Ct. Surveyed the 19th day of May 1824 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Samuel Eckles for s as dated the 22d day of March A.D. 1824. There is an improvement on the above described tract of land, which, from the best information I could obtain, was commenced in September 1821.
