



Situate in Fairview (late Newbury) township York County containing thirty acres one hundred and twenty nine perches & allowance part of a larger tract of 178⁹⁵ & allce of land surveyed by Charles Lukens then D.S. on the 25th day of April 1766 on Warrant to Tarrence Glancey dated 29th June 1763. Divided for Henry Hursh the present owner of the above part 4th November 1831.
