Situate on Rasslers Run, a branch of Saltlick or Indian Creek in Saltlick township, Fayette County, incorrectly surveyed some years ago, and now Resurveyed and corrected, in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated the 5th day of October 1831 and in consequence of a Warrant in the names of Hugh Guering & Daniel Rassler Jr for 400 as dated the 8th day of January 1808.

There is 15 or 16 acres in a state of cultivation, a cabin erected, and a family residing on this Tract, there was a small improvement commenced previous to 1808.
