



Draft of a tract of unimproved land situate in the township of Hanover in Luzerne County, adjoining lands of John Ingalar & others containing three hundred ninety nine acres, one hundred fifty one perches of land besides, the usual allowance of 6 per Ct for roads &c. Surveyed for Casper Ingalar forty or forty one years ago as appears by blocking the line trees upon the ground and resurveyed the 7th day of May A. D. 1839. by virtue of his warrant dated the 8th day of Jan'y A. D. 1793.

N.B. The red dotted lines on the east side of the above draft show an interference of a Survey made for Geo. W. Woodward the 28th day of Feb'y 1839 by virtue of a Warrant dated 24 Decr covering about one hundred and Eight acres of land & the usual allowance.
