



By virtue of a warrant dated 21st June 1793 Surveyed 1st day of July 1867 unto William Geerhart the above described tract of Two hundred and Fifty One acres and ^{Three hundred & 3} Forty Eight perches with six per cent allowance for Roads &c. situate adjoining lands of Anthony Geerhart and Mary Geerhart, and being that part of a tract originally surveyed to William Geerhart on the 18th July 1793 - now lying in Sullivan County Pennsylvania on Waters of Fishing Creek.
