



SITUATE in West Beaver Township Snyder County containing one hundred and thirty nine acres one hundred and nineteen perches and the usual allowance of six per cents for roads &c. Surveyed for Henry Gross March 12<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1857. It being a part of a larger tract of land which was originally surveyed by William Macclay then Deputy Surveyor, for Robert Buchanan in pursuance of an order of survey granted to him bearing date at Philadelphia November 4<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1766 No 1808.
