



The above tract of land is situate on the waters of ten mile creek in East bethlehem Township Washington County containing eighteen acres and seventy three poles and allowance surveyed May 10<sup>th</sup> 1836 by William M<sup>e</sup> Ellroy Esq<sup>r</sup> for Stephen Woods late D.S. in pursuance of a warrant granted to Andrew Morgan for 20 acres dated April 23<sup>d</sup> 1836 on which land a settlement was made prior to the 28<sup>th</sup> March 1814. I have examined the above survey upon the ground and find it to be correct.
