Note, on the S 4 1/2 W Line say 2 perches to the Middle of the Creek thence down the Same to where the S 68 W line intersects adding 2 perches to the S 68 W line, say 14.6 the middle being the Line in this as well as on the other side.

Situate on Dunlap's Creek part in Manallin and part in Luzerne Township Fayette County & Surveyed the 13th day of April 1792 In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1st day of March 1787
