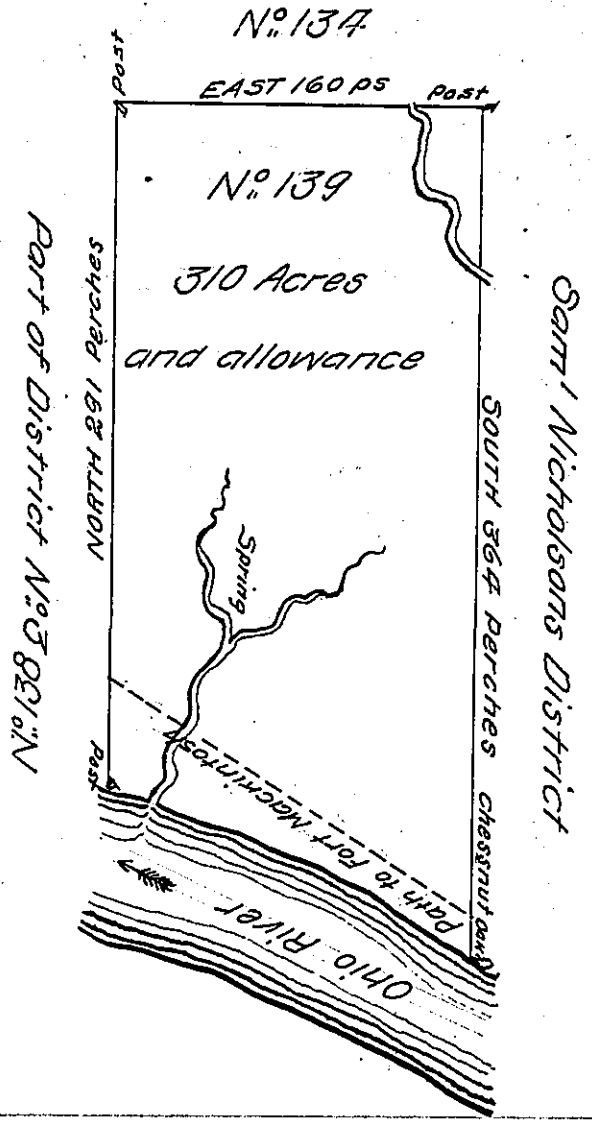

In pursuance of act of assembly pass<sup>d</sup> the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for sale of certain lands therein mentioned and by virtue of a commission under the hand and seal of office from John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the state of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783 The above tract of land containing Three hundred and Ten acres and allowance of 6 P Cent for roads was surveyed on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1785
