Containing as above set forth 10⁰⁰ & 149 perches & allowance &c. being part of a larger tract of 319 1/2⁰⁰ & allowance which was originally surveyed on the 16th day of May 1752 for William Smith by George Stevenson late D.S. In pursuance of a warrant for 100⁰⁰ Granted to James Graham bearing date the 20th day of August AD^o 1747 Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land on the 15th day of December 1814 and at the request of Peter Hoffman the present owner the same is returned for confirmation
