By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Tenth day of September, 1734, Surveyed unto Paul Heple a tract of land situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a post thence by Vacant Land South West one hundred and thirty seven perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land North West one hundred and twenty four perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and thirty seven perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and twenty four perches to the place of Beginning, containing one hundred acres with the usual allowance of six per Cent. Surveyed the 9th of 1734. By Nich^o Deull
