



By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries dated the thirty first day of March 1733. Surveyed to John Hock a tract of land situate in Oley in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a post in a line of the said John's other Land thence by the same North East one hundred forty two perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land North West sixty perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South West one hundred forty two perches to a post, thence by other land of the said John South East sixty perches to the place of Beginning, Containing fifty acres with the usual allowance of six perches, Surveyed Feb<sup>r</sup> 22, 1734
