



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the twenty sixth day of February 1733. Surveyed unto Samuel High a Tract of land situate in Oley in the County of Luzerne. Beginning at a post a corner of John Turks land thence by the same South East ninety two perches to a post. Thence by land of Hans Fidler Your Tenant South West thirty seven perches to a post. Thence by land belonging to the heirs of Edward Evans dec^d North West ninety two perches to a corner of the said Samuel High's ^{other} land thence by the same North East thirty seven perches to the place of Beginning containing twenty acres with the usual allowance of six per cent. Surveyed 2^d of June 1734.
