 of March 1733, Surveyed unto George Haine on the 7th of 8^{br} 1735. A

 at a Black in ye line of Hugh Jones then N 50. West 140 paces to a Black
 oak, thence N 61. West along ye Barrens 7/8 paces to a post, thence south by
 the s. George Haine's land 90 paces to a White Oak, thence South
 East 80 paces to a Hickory, thence E by South 84 paces to a post,
 thence N 60. East by the s. Jones's land 123 paces to the place of Be-
 ginning containing 122 acres & the allowance of six p. Cent
