



A Plat of a Lot in the Town of York No. 108. Situate on the South side of High Street, containing in breadth on the said High Street sixty five feet and in length to a twenty feet Alley two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Northward with High Street, Westward with a lot of ground now in the possession of Faul Shauel No. 121. Southward with a twenty feet alley, and Eastward with a lot of ground now in the tenure of George Sokol No. 107. Entered on the plat of the said Town & Survey'd for George Hook, who has built a house on the same Lot, according to the Conditions of settling the Town, Certified at York the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1753.
