

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the twenty sixth day of October 1734. Surveyed unto Godlieb Herger a tract of land situate in Frederick Township in the County of Philad^a. Beginning at a Stone a Corner of his other land thence by the same North west eighty two perches, and by land of Henry Crup the same course sixty nine perches to a post, thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred & three perches to a post, thence by land of George Trumbull, George Hean & Christian Geatz deare, South East one hundred fifty one perches to a post, thence by land of John River South West one hundred & three perches to the place of Beginning, containing ninety one acres ^{& 112 perches} with the usual allowance of Six ¹⁰/₁₀₀ Cent. Surveyed Nov^r 11th 1734
