


By Virtue of a Warrt. from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing date the twentieth day of September Anno Domini 1738. I have Survey'd and laid out unto Benjaⁿ Moor in the Township of Hopewell in the County of Lancaster on the West Side Susquehanna river Two hundred Eighty three acres of land with allowance of six ft Bank, Beginning at a Hickery a Corner of ^{Geo} Endlose's land by the same south forty degrees Easter one hundred and forty perches to a Locust, South fifty degrees westerly twenty three perches to a White Oak, a Corner of Virginia Chadwick's land and by the same south ^{forty} fifty degrees Easterly two hundred and two perches to a Swamp Oak, Thence south fifty degrees westerly One hundred and fifty perches to a Hickery a Corner of George Hildebrand's land by the same North forty degrees Westerly two hundred thirty five perches to a Hickery Thence North nineteen degrees and a half Easterly two hundred and twelve perches and a half to the place of Beginning. Survey'd May 22^d 1739.
