 Resurveyed unto Daniel Hasell & Daniel Buckley
 1733, a tract of land situate in the County of Chester, Beginning at a Walnut
 tree by the River School Kill at a corner of William Moore's Land
 thence South West by the same of the land of James Anderson 440 pches
 to a Hickery, thence North West by the land late of Gas. Carpenter and
 Daniel Carpenter 173 pches to Black Oak, thence North East by the land
 late of David Lloyd 42.5 pches to a Hickery by the River, thence
 down the same, ^{182 pches} to the Beginning containing four hundred & seven-
 ty five acres. Resurvey'd 19th of 7th 1733.
