



Surveyed January 11th 1856 to Genl Seth Clover the above described tract of land Situate in North Mahoning Township Indiana County on the Waters of little Mahoning Creek being in the late purchase of the Indians Containing twenty four acres and one hundred and twelve perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. including an improvement made subsequent to 28th of March 1814 but no resident settlement thereon by warrant of 20th of December 1855 Bounded as above described Run at the true meridian the magnetic variation being fifty minutes West
