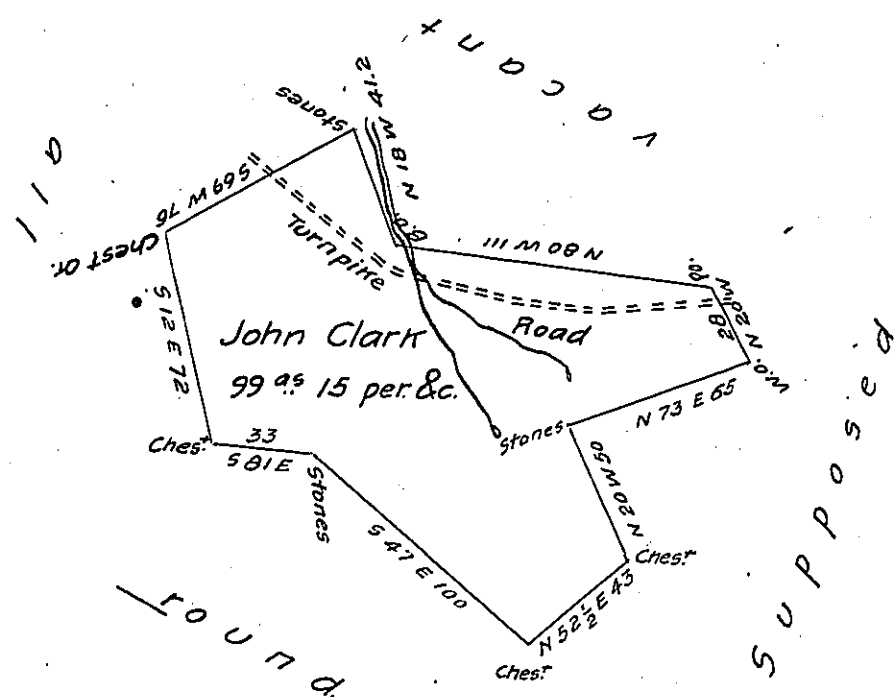

Situate in Fair field township Westmoreland County Pa. embracing the head springs of the South branch of Tub-mill Creek on the new turn-pike road leading from Johnstown to Legorier town, adjoining other mountain Land supposed Vacant.
